My Priorities

Fix Health & Care

- Shorter waits at Stoke Mandeville Hospital, NHS dentists available locally again.
- NHS funding so people can see a GP or dentist without weeks of delay. Expanding GP access through modernised facilities like Berrycroft and better primary-care planning.
- Better support for unpaid carers.

Homes People Can Afford

- No more Hampden Fields-style developments without surgeries, schools, roads and buses first.
- Affordable homes that people here can actually afford.

Transport That Works
